CINQUE TERRE PHOTOGRAPHY TOUR
18th - 22nd April 2018



With its dramatic coastline, multi-coloured villages, terraced fields rising from the azure sea and breath taking views, it's no wonder why this is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

We will focus upon the five villages (Monterosso, Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola, and Riomaggiore), as well as nearby Portovenere, accessible by boat. A walking trail, the "Sentiero Azzuro", connects the five villages and the paths out of these provide the perfect spots for dramatic views of the villages and coastline.

We'll be shooting quaint villages, vibrant colours, traditional piazzas, terraced vineyards, rugged coastline and tiny harbours. But it is perhaps the stunning sunrises, sunsets and blue hour shots that you will remember most from your trip.

The largest of the five villages, Monterosso al Mare, with its wide range of accommodation, good selection of restaurants and easy access to the other villages, is the perfect base for the tour. Our excellent hotel is located on a quiet side street just 10 minutes walk from the railway station and within easy reach of the old town.

Our time together will include individual and group discussions, inspiring ideas and great fun. I cannot think of a better location to express your creativity than the breath-taking region of Cinque Terre!
